

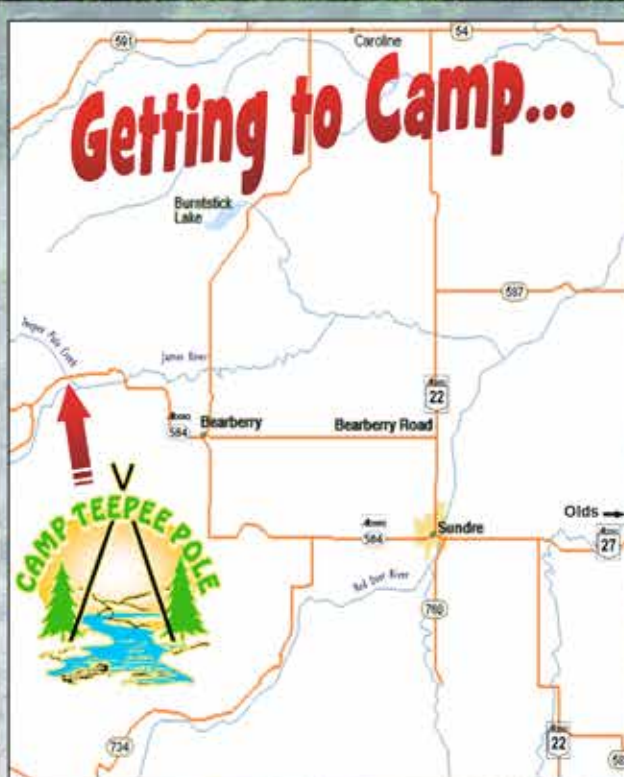

From Highway 2, turn west at the Olds overpass and follow Highway 27 through Olds and then through Sundre. Keep going west from Sundre on Highway 584 (27 becomes 584 west of Sundre). Follow all the bends through to Bearberry. Keep following the road west of Bearberry, with all its winding, and you will come to a bridge over the James River. At this point the road becomes gravel. Stay on it for 4 km and you will find Teepee Pole Creek and the sign for Camp Teepee Pole. Turn left just after the creek, at the rural address sign 82053 Alberta Highway 584. If you come to the Trunk Road (a "T" intersection) then you have gone too far.
